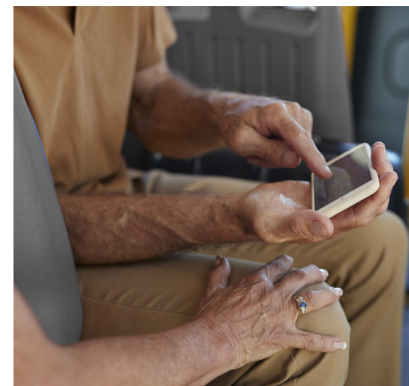
VE Day Celebrations
