Visiting Guidance

The main change is that you will no longer be required to book a visit to the home and there are no limits to the number of visitors. You will not be required to take a lateral flow test but we still ask that you continue to wear a mask in all areas of the home, including bedrooms. All our staff will continue to test twice a week via LFT
